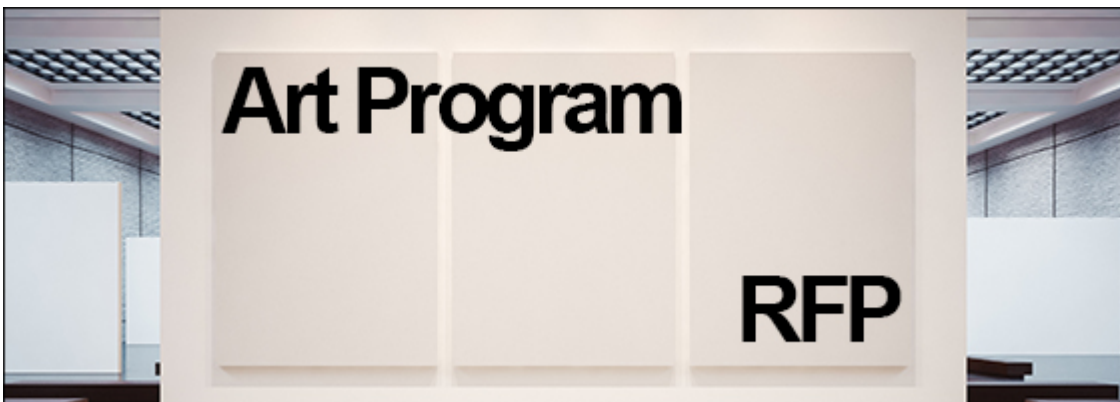
An exterior camera has also been installed on the roof on the Westin Prince Hotel. It will provide images of the geothermal solution as it is implemented at 111 Moatfield.
