Enhancing Engagement with Interns and Students

As the regulator of the practice of architecture in Ontario, the OAA is broadening its efforts to engage Interns and Students. Earlier this year, OAA Council decided to sunset its Interns Committee and transition to an advisory group model to better connect with those pursuing a licence or limited licence. The goal is to enable broader participation and ensure more involvement in key policy discussions, including licensure requirements.

OAA Conference: Special Rates... Or Win Travel, Accommodations, and Attendance!





Join Your Local Society



Renew Your Status Before April

You must renew with the OAA (and pay any associated fees if you are an intern) by **April 1**, or your status will be lapsed. **[Click here](#)** to learn more.

As a reminder, holding Student status means being actively enrolled at a School of Architecture or the RAIC Syllabus program (for Student Associates) or a three-year architectural technology program leading to an Ontario advanced diploma from a college of applied arts and technology or a TAC-accredited institution (for Student Technologists).
