### Next Edition of the OBC Expected Spring 2024

As reported in **Issue 27 of the** *Practice Advisory*, the OAA continues to monitor the anticipated release of the next edition of the Ontario Building Code by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (MMAH). The biggest overhaul since its original introduction in 1975, the 2024 edition of the Ontario Building Code is anticipated to contain approximately 2,000 changes.

On March 12, the OAA met with the MMAH to discuss updates on the new edition of the Ontario Building Code 2024. Details will be released in a future <u>CodeNews</u> about the transition period and training opportunities that will be offered to the industry. The OAA will continue to keep members updated as information is received.
